

Cookies policy

This website uses its own and third-party cookies. A cookie is a file that is downloaded to your computer when accessing certain web pages, among other purposes, ensuring the correct functioning of the page, allowing the User faster access to the selected services, storing and retrieving information about the habits of navigation of a user or their equipment and even, depending on the information they contain and the way they use their equipment, they can be used to recognize the user. Cookies are only associated with an anonymous user and the type of computer, computer or device and do not provide references that allow knowing their personal data.

The user, when browsing, accepts the cookies that are strictly necessary for the proper functioning of the website and the User's access to its services. To reject technical cookies, you can configure your browser without affecting the User's ability to access the content. However, we inform you that the rejection of the necessary cookies may reduce the proper functioning of the web.

Types of Cookies

- Depending on the entity that manages them, there are own Cookies (those that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from a computer or domain managed by the editor itself and from which the service requested by the user is provided) and third parties (Those that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from a computer or domain that is not managed by the publisher, but by another entity that processes the data obtained through cookies).
- Depending on the time they remain active, there are session ones (designed to collect and store data while the user accesses a web page) and persistent ones (in which the data is stored in the terminal and can be accessed and processed for a period defined by the person responsible for the cookie - it can range from a few minutes to several years -).
- Depending on the purpose for which they treat the information they collect, they can be:
 - Technical cookies (necessary for the use of the website and the provision of the contracted service)
 - Statistics cookies (they collect anonymous information on the use made of the web)

Techniques

Necessary cookies help make a web page usable by activating basic functions such as page navigation and access to secure areas of the web page. The website cannot function properly without these cookies.

Statistics

Statistical cookies help web page owners understand how visitors interact with web pages by collecting and providing information anonymously.

Deactivation / activation and elimination of Cookies

To restrict or block cookies, it is done through the browser settings.

If you do not want websites to place any cookies on your computer, you can adapt your browser settings so that you are notified before any cookies are placed. Similarly, you can adapt the settings so that the browser rejects all cookies, or only third-party cookies. You can also delete any of the cookies that are already on your computer. Keep in mind that you will have to adapt the configuration of each browser and equipment you use separately.

Please note that if you do not wish to receive cookies, we can no longer guarantee that our website will function properly. Some site features may be lost and you may no longer be able to view certain websites. Also, rejecting cookies does not mean that you will no longer see advertisements. - Firefox: Tools > Options > Privacy > History > Custom settings.
- Internet Explorer: Tools > Internet Options > Privacy> Settings.
- Safari: Preferences > Security.
